Use of ICT By Faculty –

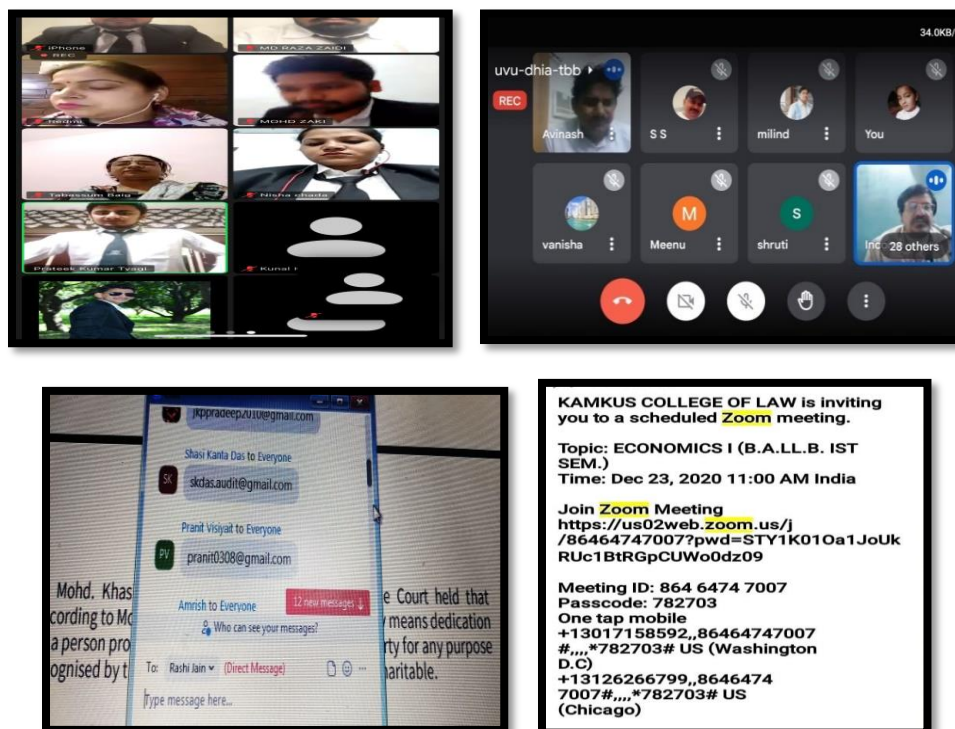

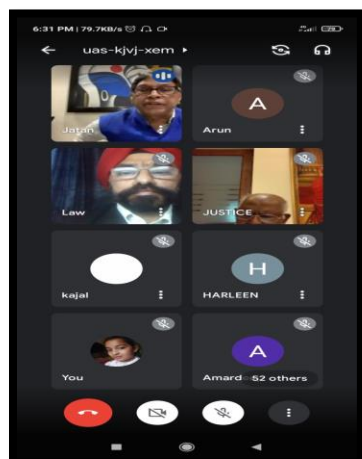
Seminar and Conference room are digitally equipped where guest lectures, expert talks and various competitions are regularly organized for students.



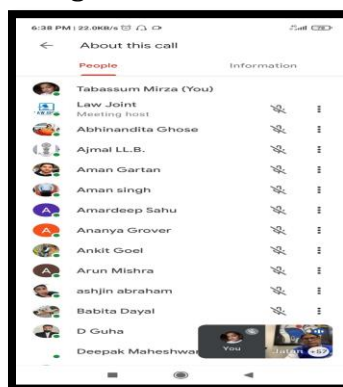
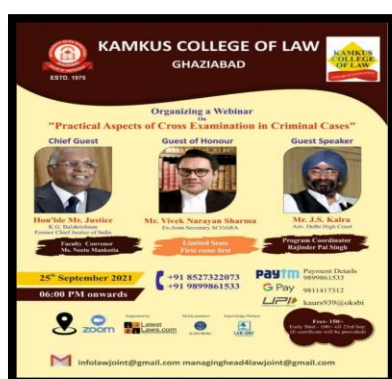
(B) Use of Online meeting application during COVID Crisis:

Online meetings with students are made using goggle meet and Zoom application to conduct online classes/webinars.

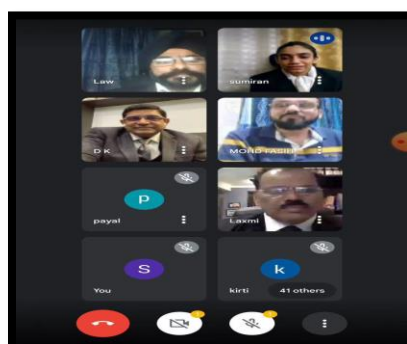

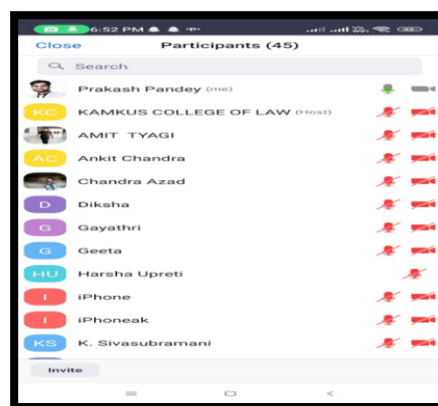
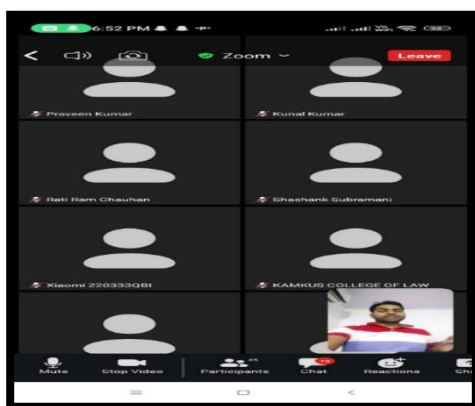
(D) Online Guest Lecture –

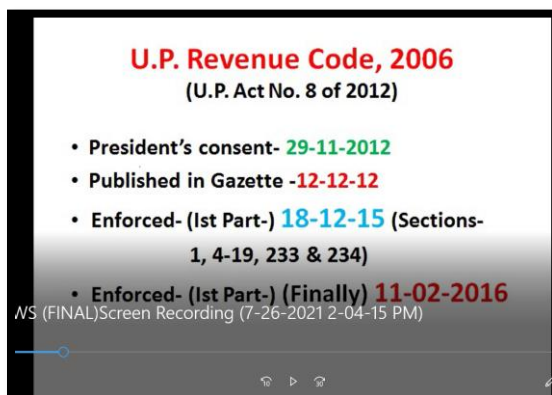
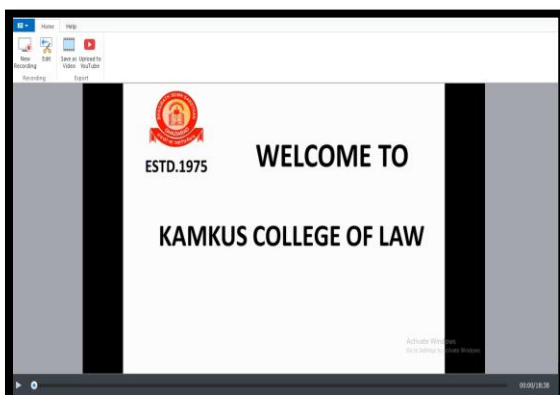
This Online lecture proved to be very useful for the students as the students got an opportunity to understand the practical aspect of taxation laws.

(G)YouTube Short-Clips on various Law Topics:

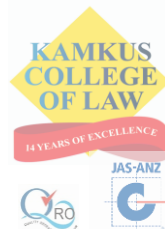


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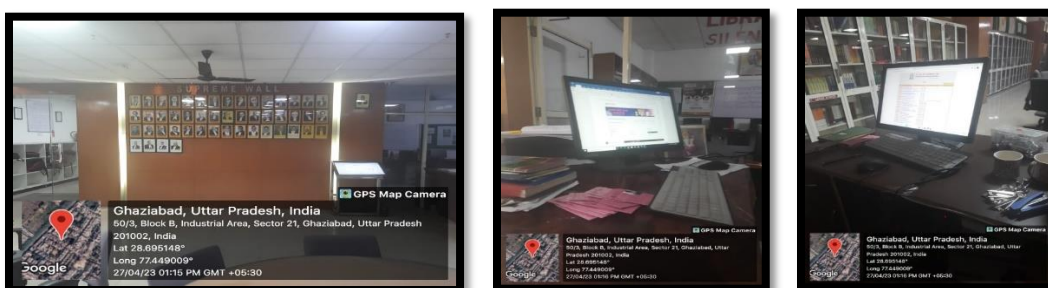
Students of KCL prepared and uploaded the short-clips on various law topics under the able guidance of teachers to acquire the deep knowledge and to motivate others.



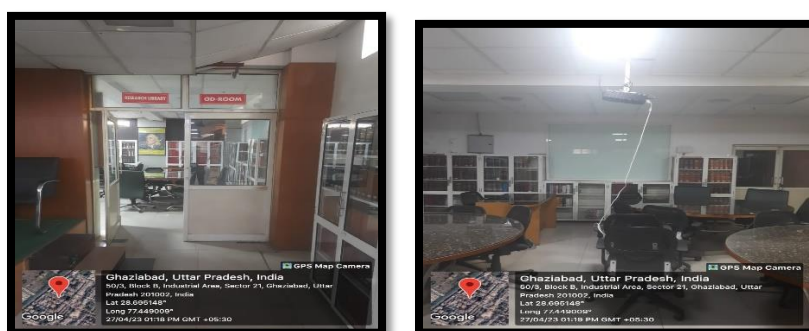
E-Resources from Library:

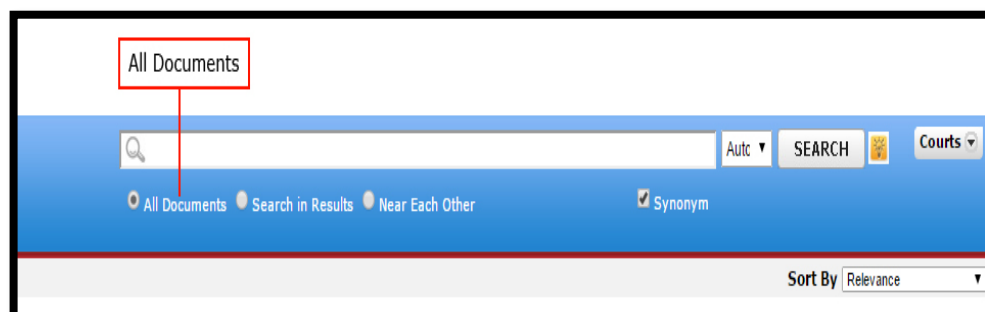
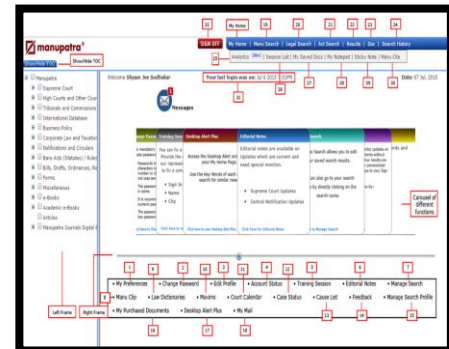

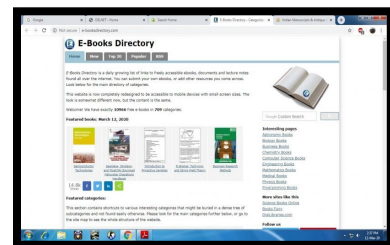




With the aim to giving first-hand information to access the Manupatra to the students and faculty members, Kamkus College of Law organized an orientation cum training workshop on “Manupatra”

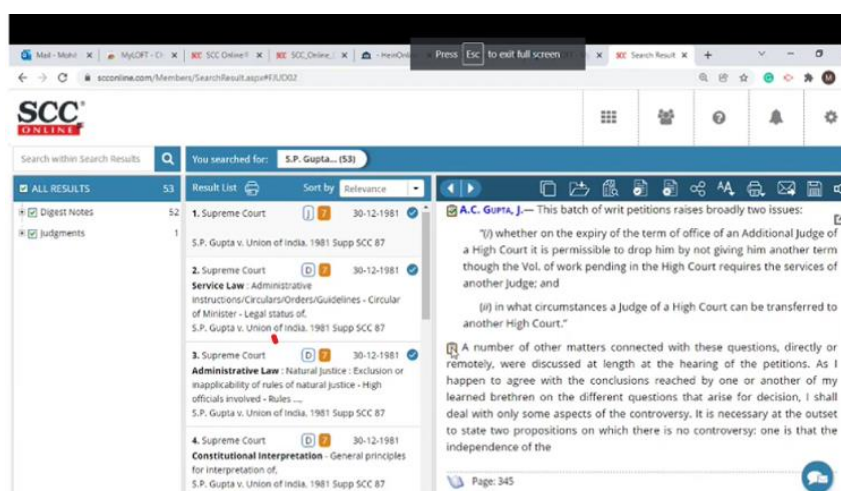
