MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. Parties

V. Amendment to the Agreement

If during the operation of the Agreement, such circumstances arise which require any alterations or modifications of the Agreement, then such required modifications/ alterations will first be mutually discussed and subsequently endorsed in the form of an appendix to the Agreement.

- (II) 2nd to 10th rank holders will receive a concession of 25% from the existing fee.
- (III) Ith to 20th rank holder will receive a concession of 20% from the existing fee
- (IV) 21st and above rank holders will receive a discount of 10% from the existing fee.


